

Of course some articles will be different. We implore you to look for yourself. We always put all our publications Online. You can see how we have


progressed over the last couple years, and make sure not


It's unfortunate Powder Horn Resort has to close with this much snow still on the mountain. It's been such as great snow year, that an encore would be awesome! Is there a person we can speak to about this?! If you haven't gotten the chance to hit the slopes, fear not. We still have options!

According to the USDA, we accumulated 167% of normal snow pack on the Grand Mesa, a drastic change from recent years. Though Powder Horn Resort is scheduled to close April  $2^{nd}$ , we can still take advantage of all this

snow at Old Powder Horn.

If they have their kids with them, plowing down Old Powder Horn may not be the best idea, it's still a good place for sledding though. If you don't have the moxie to drop in from the top of Old Powder Horn and still need to scratch that skiing itch, plenty of skiing is still open around Colorado.

Sunlight closes the same time as Powder Horn, but Arapahoe Basin isn't scheduled to close until June! It's quite the drive, so you better make a weekend out of it. Well worth the trip though!



# Outlaw Country

It's an honor to catch so much talent in one night! The Ute Theater presented Garfield County with a musical smorgasbord of unique sound. From a soloist, to an all female band, and Exit 42 from Mesa County! We got to hear a little of everything.

Mr. Ranen Ware, up first, explained before his set that he hadn't performed in quite a while, and his nerves were a little jittery. However, he did a wonderful job of pushing his nervousness aside with a comical ditty from artist Roger Miller. The ice breaking tactic worked for him and the crowd, as every-

one settled in for a great evening.

Next up, the Queen Bees, an all female band shown to the right. These ladies also play in both counties, and have been together for 3 years. They have a very melodic sound and play a variety of songs including originals and a classic favorite, Jolene.

The four ladies; Portia Rogers playing guitar and mandolin, Joey Ball on guitar and vocals, Pam Rosenthal playing the upright bass and Aundrea Ware on vocals, gave a wonderful performance including some historical facts about some of the artists they like to cover, such as the Judd Sisters, who were once called the Soap Sisters. The Queen Bees are recording an album soon and hope you keep your eye open for it! You can find these gals buzzing around at the Brew Zone in Rifle, April 15<sup>th</sup>.

The Queen Bees were fol-

lowed by Feeding Giants. If someone looks familiar, believe your eyes! Mrs. Aundrea Ware is in both bands on vocals, but sounds completely different.


The two bands have big differences, mainly Mr. Ware, who's bass voice stands out clearly. The three member band, consisting of Kevin and Aundrea Ware, and Max Tustin, have been around 10 years, with Max joining the band about 5 years ago. This concert was held by the Ute Theater Society, which is a nonprofit. The proceeds went to local scholarships for high school seniors around Garfield County who are going into the Arts. The Society has been doing this for the past 3 years and started a *Patio Series* during Covid.

### Wishin' A FISH

Mesa County Connection hasn't done an article on the Fruita side of the Valley in quite a while. In an attempt to include you, we cruised to Highline Lake for fishing. After being told it was closed, we were diverted to Mack Lake.

This small lake, which we were told was stocked, provided hope that fishing would be a bountiful endeavor. If we could have endured the ominous weather to let hooks set for more than a half hour, we may of caught something. However, as spring snowflakes fell, and starvation was not a main concern, packing up and heading to a guaranteed spot, seemed the smart thing to do. Let's be honest, the thrill of the catch is more enticing than wondering if the ducks are catching more than you.

Highline Lake was the first choice for this area, but due to Freshwater mussel treatment, as the Ranger stated, it was closed for fishing and we decide Corn Lake is our best option. To get these boys some action, we headed across the county to a location where fish put up a fight every time.

Unlike the lonely shores of Mack Lake, people were on the banks of Corn Lake enjoying the day. The clouds parted as they sometimes do over the Valley, and then snag, young Liam, to the bottom left, catches himself a fish. As his Dad states, "This is his favorite thing to do, and he would do it all day if he could", weather permitting.


