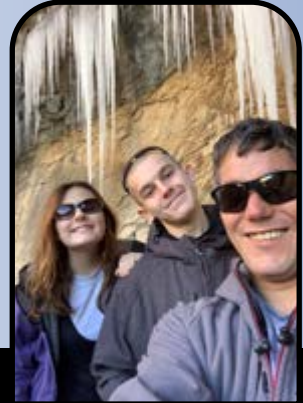

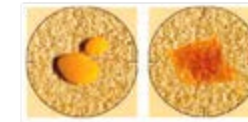

GOOD BYE SWEET SKI SEASON!

It's unfortunate Powder Horn Resort has to close with this much snow still on the mountain. It's been such a great snow year, that an encore would be awesome! Is there a person we can speak to about this?! If you haven't gotten the chance to hit the slopes, fear not. We still have options!

According to the USDA, we accumulated 167% of normal snow pack on the Grand Mesa, a drastic change from recent years. Though Powder Horn Resort is scheduled to close April 2nd, we can still take advantage of all this snow at Old Powder Horn.

Not a lot of people have access to such great skiing. Leanne and Chis Garner to the left and top-right, are from Florida. They barely made it before the end of the



season. They say the last time they were skiing was 15 years ago, and would have been heartbroken if they had missed it! If you have family coming and they missed Powder Horn Resort, and need a snow day, bring your lunch and make your way up to Old Powder Horn.

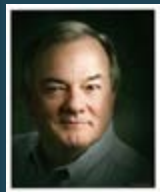
If they have their kids with them, plowing down Old Powder Horn may not be the best idea, it's still a good place for sledding though. If you don't have the moxie to drop in from the top of Old Powder Horn and still need to scratch that skiing itch, plenty of skiing is still open around Colorado.

Sunlight closes the same time as Powder Horn, but Arapahoe Basin isn't scheduled to close until June! It's quite the drive, so you better make a weekend out of it. Well worth the trip though!

Aspen, Buttermilk, Ski Cooper, Crested Butte, Echo Mountain, Eldora, Keystone, Purgatory, Snowmass, Telluride and Winter Park all close in April, though most of these will be in the middle, to the end of the month. Breckenridge and Loveland will be open until May.

Enjoy the snow while it lasts! Before too long, the stifling heat will be back, and pleasant thoughts of pictures like the one to the top left will be dancing in our heads. If the snow continues like this over the next few years, maybe Powder Horn Resort can plan on staying open longer.

It's an honor to catch so much talent in one night! The Ute Theater presented Garfield County with a musical smorgasbord of unique sound. From a soloist, to an all female band, and Exit 42 from Mesa County! We got to hear a little of everything.

Mr. Ranen Ware, up first, explained before his set that he hadn't performed in quite a while, and his nerves were a little jittery. However, he did a wonderful job of pushing his nervousness aside with a comical ditty from artist Roger Miller. The ice breaking tactic worked for him and the crowd, as everyone settled in for a great evening.



Next up, the Queen Bees, an all female band shown to the right. These ladies also play in both counties, and have been together for 3 years. They have a very melodic sound and play a variety of songs including originals and a classic favorite, Jolene.

The four ladies; Portia Rogers playing guitar and mandolin, Joey Ball on guitar and vocals, Pam Rosenthal playing the upright bass and Aundrea Ware on vocals, gave a wonderful performance including some historical facts about some of the artists they like to cover, such as the Judd Sisters, who were once called the Soap Sisters. The Queen Bees are recording an album soon and hope you keep your eye open for it! You can find these gals buzzing around at the Brew Zone in Rifle, April 15th.

The Queen Bees were fol-



lowed by Feeding Giants. If someone looks familiar, believe your eyes! Mrs. Aundrea Ware is in both bands on vocals, but sounds completely different.

The two bands have big differences, mainly Mr. Ware, who's bass voice stands out clearly. The three member band, consisting of Kevin and Aundrea Ware, and Max Tustin, have been around 10 years, with Max joining the band about 5 years ago. You can see them again May 20th at the Topsy Trout in Basalt. However, Kevin Ware, Ranen Ware and Max will be playing at the Brew Zone in Rifle April 29th. They implore you to come and see!

Exit 42 is synonymous with Mesa County, since their name is Palisade's main exit from I-70. They are quickly becoming sensational across the Western Slope. They stand out with their use of the Peddle Steel Guitar. A great performance and a variety of instrumental talent makes them a must see show!

This concert was held by the Ute Theater Society, which is a nonprofit. The proceeds went to local scholarships for high school seniors around Garfield County who are going into the Arts. The Society has been doing this for the past 3 years and started a *Patio Series* during Covid.

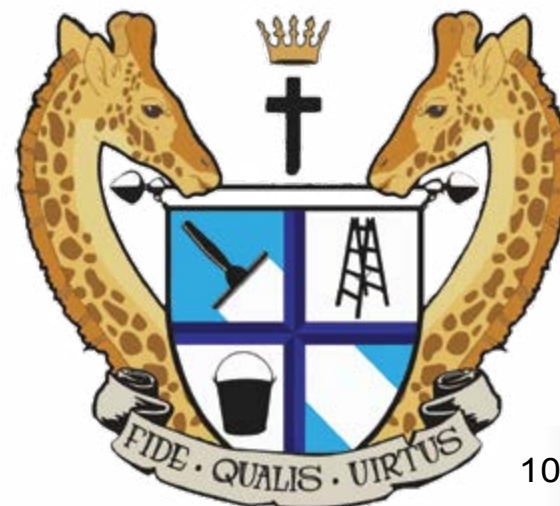
