You may be familiar with the above scene. This treacherous road that can slay suspension and tires is planned to be fixed soon!

There is no way around it. If you are going shopping off Wulfsohn Road, brakes are pressed and serpentine maneuvering is required. These “pot-pools” as they should be called, are out of control.

Don't worry, the City of Glenwood knows all about it! Matthew Langhorst from the City Streets department says “the project is out to bid now, and the bids are due back May 5th. We intend to start the project this year and finish as much as time and budget will allow in 2023.”

They also indicate that they are adding a roadway lane expansion on W. Meadows; however, the main concern is removing and replacing the damaged road with a better design. Though no plans could be found on the city's website, the Streets Department was excited to talk about the reconstruction process, and ensure the public that plans are in the works for these streets.

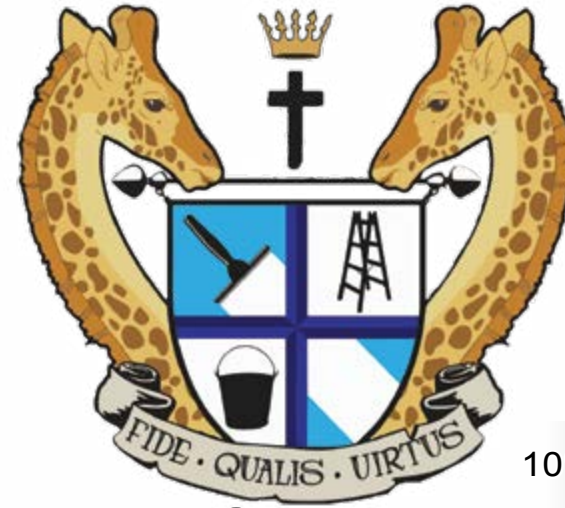
