

It's an absolute pleasure to see the look on kids' faces' when they hear the chest rumbling boom released at the drag way! Elation and smiles seemed to be the theme of this Father's Day weekend.


Contestants compete in three classes; however, racers were also there to "Test & Tune" their vehicles, and gain licenses to drive them here. Western Colorado Dragway being the only drag strip between Denver and Roosevelt, Utah, attracts enthusiasts from across the Western Slope and Eastern Utah.

Trent Dinkel seen below, is a local racer showing off his pristine Dodge titled "Wedge Hammer", which is under the AFX category. For those of us who don't know drag way terminology, FX stands for Factory Experimental, which is used for cars that have been altered, either by modifying stock parts, super charging the engine, and/ or, altering the wheel base. The "A" comes from Aurora, which was a plastics corporation in the 70's, who started altering the bodies of cars, as well as the engine. They also introduced Slot Cars and related accessories in 1971.

The other classes racing this weekend were Pro, No Box

and Junior Dragster. With it being Father's Day weekend, it is imperative that we mention a family team who seems to race all categories. Including the youngest.

On the top right is the Devaney family and Grandpa Yurick. Grandpa Yurick has been a fan of racing for 40 years and finally



bringing titles home right away. This first place trophy was awarded to him

on the very first race of the season here at Western Colorado Dragway.

It's inspiring to see a family team like this supporting the continuation of drag racing. They started early with Carson, and hope to see him progress to Pro and Super Pro down the line.




If you are downtown on 8th & Grand Avenue, you will notice plaques on the wall of the shared building of Colorado Mountain College and the Glenwood Springs Chamber, which reads, "From New Castle to

> Parachute, Glenwood Springs to Eagle, Carbondale to Aspen, the farmers of the local valleys produce some of the states finest fruits, vegetables and dairy products.

The need for expanded markets and better prices for their produce prompted the farmers to organize an event, better yet, a tradition: Strawberry Days". The plaque goes on to speak about the very first Strawberry Days, which was agriculturally based, and geared towards showing off the best of local farmer's produce. 128 years later, the plump, delicious strawberries that were celebrated a century ago have seem

to become a myth.





Scalpers

As the summer months heat up, don't be decieved by the devious scams surrounding event tickets. Scalpers go out of their way to get your money. The only way to get around this, is doing some good ol' fashion research.


Maybe convenience is worth a 20 - 50% hike in price. Not everyone wants to go to multiple websites to find the perfectly priced ticket. With some major events, you are forced to go through giant monopolies such as Ticket Master, However, some of our local shows, or maybe even some that run on a circuit, have their own website and lower ticket prices.

Take for instance this Paranormal Cirque coming to Mesa County between June and July. On their home website you can get tickets from \$15 - \$60 depending on the your seat. The same ticket on Vividseats runs \$42 - \$86. That's Double!

The same goes for the smallest local events. There are companies reselling Grand Junction Jackalope tickets starting at \$10 over face value.

There is no Federal Law prohibiting the resale of tickets. While some states have laws, there is nobody governing the overall market. Besides the Internet being too vast for a state to keep track of, they probably have better things to do.

The only real conclusion is to be very careful when buying tickets. You can get Grand Junction Jackalope Baseball tickets starting at \$10 on their website.


