



Art Center Spotlight The Launchpad & Carbondale Arts

If you're from Carbondale, you probably already know. The Launchpad is a staple in the community. For more than 50 years, this place has been providing the area with a remarkable loca-

tion to bring Art & Culture alive in the surrounding community!

Founded in the early 70's by community members who knew the importance of promoting a vibrant art scene in Carbondale, The Launchpad and Carbondale Arts, combine teaching, creating and selling local art under one roof. They house several entities in the industry, such as the Dance Initiative. It also offers space for various performing arts, displays local fine arts and has a wonderful garden and mini amphitheater in back.

Carbondale Arts and Dance Initiative are the facilitator of The Launchpad, a nonprofit organization who believes in building partnership, "Collaboration with local governments, schools, artists, businesses and other nonprofits are the key to our mission: building community through art"1. They rent space for The Launchpad, act as the Art Counsel for Carbondale, and liaison for events, such as Mountain Fair.

Upon entering the building you may be curious about the drapes hanging from the ceiling. The spry lady above, and gentleman below, are members of the Sopris Soarers. The aerial acrobats take

up a big section of the building, and are the primary renters. They are instructing classes through October. and if you aren't up for trying it out, they invite you to watch. They perform at various events and festivals, including Mountain Fair, which happened in the later part of July, or you can just come by The Launchpad when they are practicing.


Inside you will also discover a fine arts gallery and promenade, which displays local artists' creations for sale. Justin Squier's art, on the bot-

tom right, is just one of several artists you will have check out for yourself. Titled "Round and Around" the "vintage wooden sign" piece elements were acquired in Fruita.

The "Artique" gift shop, in the middle, allows the opportunity to buy a souvenir. All the items are unique and mostly made locally. The funds go back into the program and you'll be helping a working artist.





HANGING

If you don't know Hanging Lake and live in Garfield County, it's possible you live under a rock! Located about halfway through Glenwood Springs Canyon, is a place known to most around the Western Slope. It might be out of the way, and you have to plan in advance, sometimes a week or two, but Hanging Lake is worth the visit!

It had better be the central part of your day, because there is no return to east bound I-70. This magnificent place, which is no joke getting to, needs reservations! They go quick too. If you want an early morning venture on this trail, you might have to plan weeks in advance.

Of course, when you have a place like this, it will knowingly attract people from all over. Because it is now an iconic destination point, as Ken Murphy from Glenwood Adventure points out, access to the location needed to be regulated.

Ken and Glenwood Adventure have been managing the area along side the U.S. Forest


Service since 2019. Ken says, "the place had be-

it into a managed use recreation area so everyone could have the opportunity to enjoy it."

It is still busy, but because they only allow 60 reservations per hour, you are periodically left alone with nature. There were no local visitors, everyone passing by said they were from out of town. Above and to the right are Gina and Gary from Breckenridge. This was their first time, but recommended taking the time to enjoy Spout Waterfall. They plan on returning, and didn't mind that it

was a managed access area.

The cost is \$12 per person and the funds go to help manage the area, and to the U.S. Forest Service to upkeep the trail. There are many restrictions, which you will see when making your reservations, and will also be reiterated to you once



HANGING LAKE TRAIL come so congested, that it was necessary to turn




you get there. It is quite the hike, more than 1,000 feet in just over a mile. The treacherous terrain and slick rock might not be for everyone; however, there are plenty of places to sit along the way, and appreciate the breath taking beauty. There are waterfalls all along the trial, as well as historical facts, and information on this small cabin to the left, which housed some of the earlier forest tenders.

The way down is faster, and somewhat scary; however, the decline angle is welcome after such an elevated journey. Descending the stair case might give you vertigo, but there is a handrail, and even though it looks a hundred years old, it's still strong as ever.






