

Mandala Stones are the perfect way to bring a healing community together. Peer 180 RCO (Recovery Community Organization-& Center) is a

non-profit organization dedicated to recovery, support and community. This unique, all-inclusive program, is here for anyone struggling with substance abuse issues and their families and supporters. The opposite of addiction is connection.

The Creating in Recovery Program recently created stone mandalas. The word "Mandala" is originally a Sanskrit term for "circle". The contextual meaning is deeper than one typically

imagines. Geometric symbols are used for a spiritual, emotional and psychological purpose. This type of art has been used to help people for thousands of years! It can help a person meditate, relax and clear their mind. It's also a great way to include the kids! Peer 180 RCO has a variety of programs to assist people, and support all pathways of recovery.

There is absolutely no excuse for being so careless as to leave the trash you brought, or not manage your campsite in a way that is conducive to fire prevention. It should be common sense.

This rant is brought you by the fact of stumbling upon someone's campsite with a fire pit strewn about, embers smoldering on a trail not far, and anger for anyone so distracted with their own life to make sure their area is secure.

This fire pit to the right, not far from the shores of Cottonwood Lake number one, is a disgrace and disservice to your forest and fellow campers. Half burnt timber left in places known to be dry, and prone to wildfire, is beyond ignorant. There is already plenty that could happen without someone absentmindedly leaving super dry tinder around.

Not far from that camp, is trail wrapping around the lake. It's lined with a tree rotted to the point of turning to saw dust. In the middle, small embers were smoldering. 

HANGINGLake

No, it isn't in Mesa County. It's way too beautiful to leave out though! Located about halfway through Glenwood Springs Canyon, is a place known to most around the Western Slope. It might be out of the way, and you have to plan in advance, sometimes a week or two, but Hanging Lake is worth the visit!

It had better be the central part of your day, because there is no return to east bound I-70. This magnificent place, which is no joke getting to, needs reservations! They go quick too. If you want an early morning venture on this trail, you might have to plan weeks in advance.

Mr. Ken Murphy, of Glenwood Adventure, who manages the area said "it was necessary to turn this area into a Managed Use Recreation Area. The place had become so congested, that it was necessary for someone



to control the flow of visitors". He isn't exaggerating either. The area, which only had out-of-towners, was very busy. They let 60 visitors in per hour, for a 3 hour tour.

The cost is \$12 per person, and the funds go to help manage the area, and to the U.S. Forest Service to upkeep the trail. There are guite a few restrictions, which you will see making your reservations, and reiterated once you get there. It is quite the hike, more than 1,000 feet in just over a mile, with some treacherous terrain and slick rocks, which seem to be metal ore, shined by the feet of a thousand people **Connecting Community**
