According to the Town of De Beque's website, "The first Wild Horse Days started in 1999. A group of De Beque residents formed a Non-profit organization/ Council which consisted of a President, Secretary and board. This Council was started to aid and help the Wild Horses in the Little Bookcliffs Wild Horse Area. It was a yearly summer event. The Wild Horse Council purchased a mustang yearly from BLM for WHD. The horse was then entered into a drawing for ownership. They brought in vendors, live music, food, kids games, as well as events for adults. In 2013 the Wild Horse Committee dissolved. At that time, the Town of De Beque Recreation Department decided to start De Beque Days and follow a similar schedule of events. Initially, there was a great deal of discussion about going back to the title, Wild Horse Days A meeting was held to receive public input on what the event name should be. The name De Beque Wild Horse Days was once again chosen. Wild Horse Days is currently run by the Town of De Beque, Recreation Department".

There are "traditional festival" aspects of the event, such as a parade and car show; however, there are some parts that will leave you breathless. When the pies come out, and the rubber starts flying, it's time to take a deep breath and hold it. A face pie throwing auction was held, where public officials such as the Marshall were volunteered to be recipients of cream pies to the face. That, and the Burnout Competition was a first for Mesa County Connection. We were

all excited to see the billowing clouds of burnt rubber smoke, unless you were unfortunate enough to open your mouth as it came by!

The Town of De Beque and community are very warm and welcoming. They invite you to checkout next years event, or come down anytime during the week from 9am - 5pm for information about Little Bookcliffs Wild Horse Range.
